Bid Leveling:

Bid leveling is the process of confirming that bidders within the same bid package are pricing work on an even level with all factors considered. By normalizing all bids on a project, clients can more easily evaluate the bidders.



- **Project Description:** In 2012, EV completed the original medical office building and now Corewell has awarded us an addition and renovation, giving Corewell the opportunity to introduce new services and expand their care options in Holland. The addition will be 26,000-SF on two stories, and the renovations will refresh and reconfigure the existing building.
- **Self-Perform Trades:** We plan to use as many of our SP trades as possible and that will be determined in the coming months.
- Project Budget: \$25.0M
- Project Schedule: July, 2025, with an anticipated 18 month schedule.

This year's ball was designed by Jim O'Leary is a geodesic sphere, which is a practical choice for withstanding the strong winds of New York City. The ball is 12 feet in diameter, and weighs 11,875 pounds. It is covered with a total of 2,688 crystal triangles that vary in size, and range in length from 4 3/4 inches to 5 3/4 inches per side.



## Corewell Health Blodgett Floors 2, 3 and 6 - Renovation Grand Rapids, MI



- Project Description: Our team is currently working on the 3rd and final phase of the project. This phase is the largest of the three and includes the renovation of just over 18,000-SF of area on the 3rd floor of Blodgett Hospital to create a new 24 bed inpatient rehab unit with clinical support areas. The team is currently installing casework, wall protection and headwalls. Wall and floor tile are being installed as the team finishes the first coat of paint. The team's primary focus has been wrapping up complex sanitary and plumbing infrastructure connections that have affected multiple floors above and below.

### 2025 Holiday Schedule:


